About the Farm & the Goats

Copper Tail Farm is an Animal Welfare Approved goat dairy. Animal Welfare Approved products come from animals raised to the highest welfare and environmental standards. The health and happiness of the goats is at the center of almost all decisions made at the farm: their barn is cleaned weekly and they have access to 23 acres of forage and browse. They eat organic grain and local, second cut hay. Unlike many other goat dairies, the babies aren't separated from their moms at birth, and they stay with their moms until they are 8-12 weeks old, minimum. This means less milk and more work for the farmers, but it's better for the goats.

About the Farmers

After farming for a year in Oregon, Jon & Christelle McKee moved cross country in the summer of 2014 with 8 goats, 28 chickens, 2 dogs, 2 cats, and a chameleon to start Copper Tail Farm. They have built their herd to 60 Nubian and Nigerian Dwarf goats. Neither Christelle nor Jon grew up on a farm. They both jumped into farming with both feet and have never looked back. Christelle can be found running around doing one of many crafting hobbies: she loves to knit, garden, brew beer, preserve food, hike, and hang out with the goats. She started making soap in 2009. On top of all of that, after six years of teaching first grade, she is teaching middle school French. Jon wears many hats on the farm, including vet, builder, fence putter upper, fence repairer, and resident lumberjack. He enjoys ripping around the farm on his four wheeler, falling trees and cutting wood, ice fishing, the snow, and disc golf. They live on the farm in Waldoboro with their growing family.
